MEMORANDUM FOR THE ADJUTANTS GENERAL OF ALL STATES, PUERTO RICO, THE US VIRGIN ISLANDS, GUAM AND THE COMMANDING GENERAL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

SUBJECT: (All States Log Number I02-0028) Training Year 2002 School Funding Guidance

1. Due to the tragic events of 9/11, the Army National Guard has been focused on Homeland Security missions in support of the current National Strategy on the war against terrorism. The result of this shift in focus has caused great turbulence in the States TY 02 collective training plans. Now that the current operational environment has stabilized, the Director Army National Guard has authorized the use of TDC 111 to fund soldiers to attend only DMOSQ and Professional Development courses for the remainder of TY 02. This authorization will assist the States in attaining their readiness goals for the year.
2. TDC 111 Guidelines.
 - a. Soldiers are only authorized to attend school in TDC 111 or annual training status, not both.
 - b. School must be for a two-week period.
 - c. No additional Budget Activity 1 funds will be provided by NGB to execute TDC 111.
3. The National Guard Bureau, Training Division will distribute \$3,000,000 in Budget Activity 2 (BA2) in April 2002 for centrally managed courses. The April 2002 distribution is the final BA2 reimbursement for centrally funded courses guaranteed in TY 02. If additional funding is made available, it will be sent to the States.
4. This memorandum expires 30 April 2003, unless sooner rescinded or superseded.
